



PROCESS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF COACH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

As per scheme approval, personnel in the following categories can apply for undertaking courses under this scheme:

1. Sports Coaches (All Olympic Sport's)
2. Fitness Trainers
3. Sports Psychologist
4. Sports Physiotherapist
5. Sports Biomechanics Expert
6. Sports Nutritionists
7. Sports Masseurs

In addition, ex-players who have represented India/State at the international/level and want to pursue their career in sports coaching, sports science or support staff are also eligible wherein they can undertake Degree/Diploma courses through this scheme

PROCESS FOR APPLICATION

MPDSYW will receive applications for these courses during the following dates (for FY 2019-20). The form to be filled along with all necessary information and attachments is provided as Annexure 1. This form will be made available online at mpdsyw.gov.in. Applications window will be as follows:

- 1) October 24th 2019 to November 14th 2019
- 2) February 1st 2020 to February 15th 2020

EVALUATION COMMITTEE FOR SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS

Two evaluation committees will be formed to scrutinize and approve all received application. The committee for nominations from MPDSYW coaches/support staff:

Senior coach of particular sport/field (from MPDSYW)	Member
Technical Expert who is a senior coach or senior player of the particular sport/field	Member

Invitee from MP State Association of that Sport	Member
Deputy Director, Finance, MPDSYW	Member

Director, MPDSYW shall have the discretion to decide on individual to be nominated as Technical Expert in this committee.

Economy class air-fare, Accommodation at min. 3-star hotel and honorarium of maximum Rs. 15,000 per visit to be provided to Technical Expert.

A quorum of minimum 3 attendees (with Chairman's attendance being mandatory) will be required during evaluation of all applications.

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS

The committee will evaluate the proposal based on following parameters:

Parameter	Points
Performance of the applicant during his/her tenure at MPDSYW (for MPDSYW applicants) OR Achievements of the applicant as coach/support staff and as player	Excellent – 30 Points Good – 20 Points Average – 10 Points Poor – 0 Points
Quality of the coaching program that candidate has applied for	Excellent – 30 Points Good – 20 Points Average – 10 Points Poor – 0 Points
Appropriateness for the training program for the applicant	Very Appropriate – 20 Points Appropriate – 10 Points Not Appropriate – 0 Points
Expected benefit that will accrue after applicant undertakes the program (considering the quality of trainees whom applicant will coach/support after finishing the program)	Very beneficial – 20 Points Beneficial – 10 Points Not Beneficial – 0 Points

The minimum points for proposal to become eligible for qualification will be **60 points**.

In case there are fewer proposal approved in first window, the number of vacant training slots will be moved to the next window.

POST-TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

- 1) In case of MPDSYW candidates, the following bond period will be applicable after completion of training:
 - a. International Training Program: 2 years
 - b. Domestic Training Program: 1 year
 - c. Skill upgradation program: 6 months
- 2) In case of non-MPDSYW candidates, they will have to compulsorily work with a sports organization providing relevant services in Madhya Pradesh for a period of 2 years after completion of training
